English Literature consists of two examinations. One concentrates on Modern Fiction texts and the other on Poetry Across Time. The students have all completed a controlled assessment concentrating on Shakespeare and the Literary Heritage, which makes up 25% of their final grade. The rest is gained through these two examinations.
