Advice and Guidance

Students are placed on the iGCSE pathway when they have not managed to reach their target grades in their practice examinations and in their internal controlled assessments. This path provides them with one last chance to get their internal grades up to a level sufficient to have them able to walk into the examination with confidence.

Students on this programme have been placed in a special class with a specialist English teacher for two periods a week, a two-period examination support tutorial with 4 other students and they will also continue with their English Literature programme with their existing class and teacher.

The last months of Year 11 are a vital period for these students, where they will have to complete three new pieces of writing and perform a spoken presentation. They will need to be focussed and determined.

Revision Sessions

In addition to all of the after school, before school, Saturday and Easter tutorials that are advertised via the students' class site on the department website students in this path will also receive 2 hours a week extra tuition in English in groups of 5 that is designed to prepare them for the final examination.
